NEASA went to Court to request the Labour Court to urgently interdict the Council and the General Secretary from implementing both the 17 September 2014 and 8 October 2014 Management Committee meeting resolutions to request the Minister of Labour to extend the agreement to non-parties as per Section 32 of LRA.

On Tuesday 4 November 2014, the Judge due to the fact that he received some documents late, suggested to deal with the matter on Friday, 14 November 2014 and in the process give himself time to go through all the documents.


